Notification Type	Description
Violation Notice	A 1st standard notice letter is mailed to the Owner and Resident. This notice can be sent immediately upon citation.
Pre-Fine Notice	A pre-fine notice letter is mailed to the Owner and Resident. This notice cannot be cited or sent unless a minimum of 10 days have passed since the previous standard notice was sent.
Fine Notice	A fine notice letter is mailed to the Owner and Resident informing them they have been fined in the amount of \$25.00 dollars. This notice cannot be cited or sent unless a minimum of 30 days have passed since the previous pre-fine notice was sent.
Fine Notice	A fine notice letter is mailed to the Owner and Resident informing them they have been fined in the amount of \$50.00 dollars. This notice cannot be cited or sent unless a minimum of 30 days have passed since the previous fine notice was sent.
Fine Notice	A fine notice letter is mailed to the Owner and Resident informing them they have been fined in the amount of \$100.00 dollars. This notice cannot be cited or sent unless a minimum of 30 days have passed since the previous fine notice was sent.
Fine Notice	A fine notice letter is mailed to the Owner and Resident informing them they have been fined in the amount of \$125.00 dollars. This notice cannot be cited or sent unless a minimum of 30 days have passed since the previous fine notice was sent. Violation will continue to generate a fine of \$125.00 dollars for each recurrence of the same violation at this escalation level.
Auto-Close	If this violation remains fixed for 3 months after the last violation then it will automatically be closed.
